Fermentation temperature: 22-25°C

Ageing: Aged in oak (70% American, 30% French, 10% new barrels) for nine months.

TASTING NOTES

Impressive depth of colour, opaque dark cherry red. Deep and intense on the nose, revealing rich fruit (blackberry jam) and spicy (clove) aromas. Light, silky, very pleasant, culminating in a warm finish.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Wonderful in combination with a wide variety of recipes, including lamb roast, stews, and casseroles. It also pairs well with aubergine parmigiana, pasta and other dishes prepared with tomato sauce. Serve at 14-16°C.

LEGACY

Sixty-two miles (62 millas) refers to the distance between our winery in Fompedraza and the Kármán line, where the sky begins. This 100% Tinto Fino varietal, aged in French oak for nine months, originates from vineyards planted at the time of the Pago del Cielo winery's founding. The wine displays remarkable natural freshness, imparted by the elevation of the high plateau, where the grapes attain optimal ripeness.

TERROIR

Weather conditions

In Ribera del Duero, precipitation levels during the growth season were much lower compared to the previous year, down by almost half. This trend was reversed during the maturation period, from August to September, when it rained more than usual. Throughout most of the year, temperatures were higher than normal, and the summer saw a few heat waves.
