TASTING NOTES

Dark cherry colour and well covered. Intense aroma of black fruits (cherries), with a fine smoky nuance. On the palate it is velvety, juicy and full of rich fruity substance, with fine, ripe and wellpolished tannins.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

Thanks to its smooth tannins and pronounced fruity character, it is the ideal accompaniment to a wide variety of recipes such as roast lamb, stews and casseroles. It also pairs very well with aubergine parmigiana, or dishes that contain tomato sauce. Serve between 14-16°C.

TERROIR

Weather conditions

During the year, the average annual, vegetative cycle and ripening temperatures were slightly above the usual values. No significant spring frosts were recorded, although there was a slight autumn frost at the end of September in some areas. The summer period was marked by several heat waves in June, July and August, with a total of 61 days with temperatures above 30°C, including a two week heat wave in mid August. As for rainfall, the annual total was around the average, with a very rainy spring and a notably dry summer. During the ripening cycle, rainfall was practically nonexistent, with some very sporadic and localised heavy showers, and small hail episodes.
